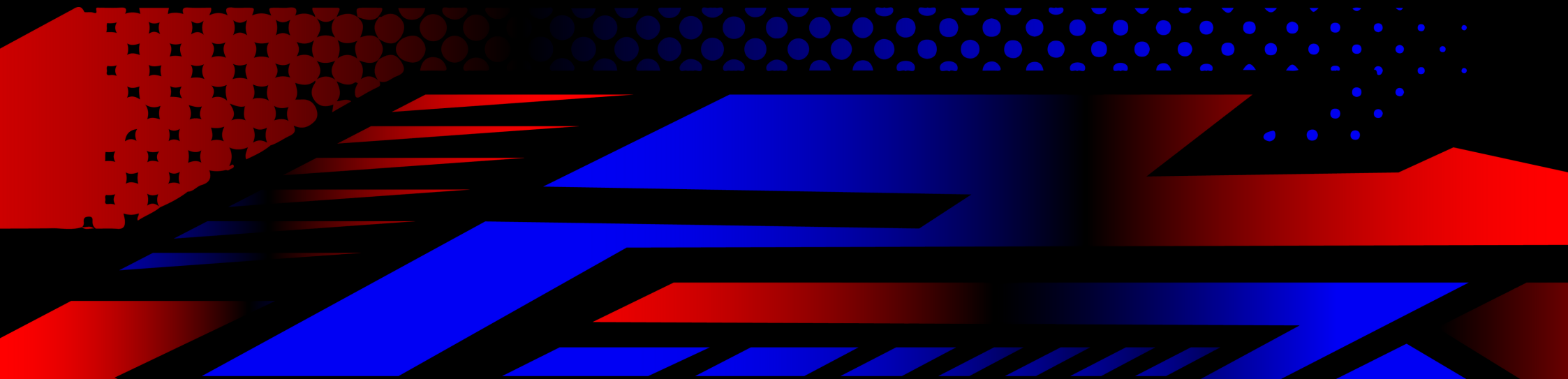

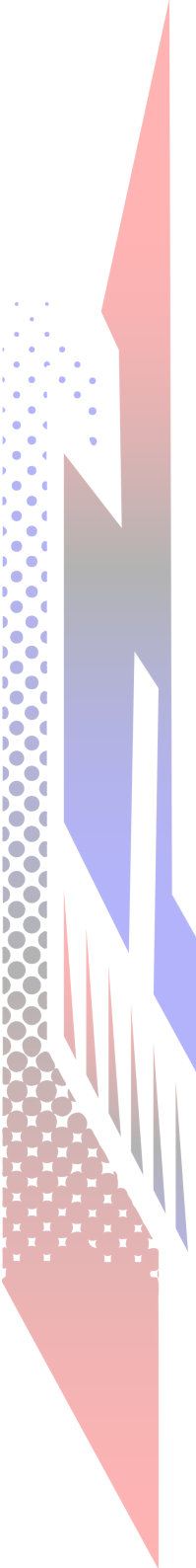

Event overview

This September, Darwin will roar into life as MXGP rips it up down under for the first time in nearly 25 years. The world's greatest riders, teams and bikes will descend on the Top End of Australia to put on one of the greatest shows in the motorsport calendar: the MXGP of Australia.

The event, hosted by Northern Territory Major Events Company, will take place on a purpose-built track at Hidden Valley Motorsports Complex in Darwin and be broadcast to over 100 countries.

Planning for the event

Purchasing tickets

Tickets can be purchased at the following link: [MXGP of Australia Tickets](#)

- All Box Offices at the venue are cashless, therefore you will need to pay with card.
 - * Unless tickets for the event are sold out prior
- Children 12 years and under are granted free entry, child tickets must be reserved at the time of adult ticket purchase. A maximum of two children per paid ticket-holding parent or guardian is permitted. Children must be supervised by their ticket-holding parent or guardian at all times during the event.
- Concession pricing is available for General Admission, single day tickets only. You can purchase concession-prices tickets if you are any of the following:
 - Full-time students
 - Pension and Senior Card holders
 - Veterans Affairs Card holders

Companion cards

Australian Companion Cards are accepted for general admission tickets at the gate when attending with a paying guest who requires assistance. Please present your card at the gate.

Assistance animals

Approved assistance animals are accepted.

Hidden Disabilities Sunflower Initiative

Northern Territory Major Events is proud to partner with the **Hidden Disabilities Sunflower Initiative** at the MXGP of Australia.

Sunflower lanyards will be free and available to collect from:

- Accessibility Information Stand
- Hidden Disabilities Sunflower Information Booth
- Event Champion Information Stand

Sunflower lanyards tell other people that you might need extra help, understanding or just more time.



Getting there

Accessible parking

Dedicated parking bays are available at the Gate 3 entrance and are clearly indicated on the event map. Please show your Australian Disability Parking Scheme Badge to the traffic controllers on arrival for access to the parking area. For patrons being dropped off, the closest drop off point is at the Gate 3 entrance.

Free public transport

All buses have low-floors and ramps to accommodate wheelchairs and light mobility aids. MXGP offers free transport to the event from CBD locations. At the bus collection point our dedicated event champions have direct contact with the bus company to ensure getting on the bus is an easy process.

Entering the event

All gates have wide lanes and are accessible. There is a recommended entry lane at Gate 3 that has been modified for wheelchair access. The lane will be signed.

Enjoying the event

Venue access

Hidden Valley is made up of rocky ground, gravel, grass and concrete paths.

There are a few catering and bar areas, each with varying access. The Main GA viewing area near the accessible viewing area is easiest to access, as this location is closest to the entry and exit. The Paddock has concrete paths and can be accessed via the internal shuttle bus and Carpentaria bus.

There is limited seating available across the site, however, there is one dedicated accessible viewing platform in general admission areas and one dedicated accessible viewing platform in Holeshott Hotel.

Accessible matting

Santos has partnered with NT Major Events to provide accessible matting onsite. Accessible matting will be laid at the dedicated accessible lane at Gate 3 and other key areas across the site.

Enjoying the event

Changing Places:

This year, there will be a portable Changing Places which offers a versatile solution to assist people with high support needs who are not adequately supported by standard accessible toilets. This is achieved through providing a larger than standard accessible toilet with extra features to meet the needs of people with disability and their carers.

Enjoying the event

Accessible bathrooms:

Locations with accessible friendly bathrooms have been marked on the map.

Accessible platforms:

Carpentaria Disability Services has partnered with NT Major Events to deliver the accessible viewing platforms. It is open to anyone requiring access due to physical or intellectual mobility. The space is not reserved and is on a first-in basis with a general admission ticket. There is one dedicated accessible viewing platform in general admission areas and one dedicated accessible viewing platform in Holeshott Hotel.

Sensory information:

The venue can be loud and crowded. Free sensory bags are available from the Hidden Disabilities Sunflower stand, with ear buds, earmuffs, communication cards and sensory toys available. There will also be a communications board and visual aid for patrons who may need additional assistance.

Enjoying the event

Support & assistance:

Located inside Gate 3 will be an accessibility information stand, where individuals booth Event staff have completed the Hidden Disabilities Sunflower training and wear the sunflower supporter lanyards if you need assistance. Please speak to one of our friendly event champions who are wearing high visibility vests and have direct communications with event control who can assist with any questions, concerns or emergencies.

Carpentaria shuttle bus:

Carpentaria Disability Services has partnered with NT Major Events to deliver an accessible shuttle bus. Operated by Carpentaria, the bus is available by contacting event control on **(08) 8928 1902** on the day. Or speak to one of our friendly event champions on site for assistance.

Public Transport

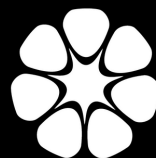
