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Volunteer Code of Conduct

- As you are representing the Foundation you must be neatly presented, friendly, approachable, and pleasant to all.
- You must agree to stay out of any restricted areas, including corporate boxes, changing rooms, and VIP areas. Please stick to your allocated areas at all times.
- During your volunteer shift you must wear the provided McGrath Foundation 'Volunteer' t-shirt and your volunteer identification around your neck – which must be worn and made clearly visible at all times. The Volunteer ID must be made available to sight by venue security and staff, McGrath Foundation staff, other associated event staff members and members of the general public.
- When collecting money be thankful and also careful to handle the money with care, placing it in your allocated collection bucket and returning it safely to the McGrath Foundation team at the end of your shift.
- During your shift, and when you are wearing a 'Volunteer' t-shirt and representing the McGrath Foundation, you must not consume alcohol, smoke or vape.
- You must return your provided 'Volunteer' t-shirt, volunteer ID and lanyard to McGrath Foundation staff at the end of your shift.
- If you experience someone being rude to you, report this to a McGrath Foundation staff member who will manage the situation for you.
- If you are unsure of anything, please ask. McGrath Foundation staff are here to help you.
- You may be photographed or filmed during your volunteer shift. By participating, you agree to allow the McGrath Foundation to share these photos and videos, including (but not limited to) social media, website, newsletters, reports and marketing materials. If you do not wish to have your image used, please inform a staff member prior to or during the event.
